If, at any time, you feel that you would rather report this to a deputy, please discontinue using this system and call 805-683-2724

What do I do if online incident reporting is not right for me?

What if this happened in another jurisdiction can I file a report using this system?

No. If a crime took place in another county or jurisdiction (The City of Santa Barbara, City of Lompoc, City of Santa Maria, City of Guadalupe or UCSB) please call that jurisdiction's law enforcement agency.

What is a known suspect?

A known suspect is when you or someone else knows the person or where to find the person who committed the crime or the license plate number of the vehicle the suspect(s) were in.
