# Faith Watch Principles

The Santa Barbara County Sheriff's Office Faith Watch Program is designed to bring law enforcement services to churches, synagogues and mosques within the County of Santa Barbara. This program was developed by staff of the Santa Barbara Sheriff's Office and will provide three types of law enforcement services to the religious communities.

# Crime Prevention Programs

The first goal of Faith Watch is to serve the individual members of the congregation by offering programs relating to crime prevention. In this segment, personnel will meet with staff and/or congregants to provide information about personal safety, burglary prevention, home security, fraud, scams and identity theft as well as drug awareness and vehicle theft. These programs may be conveniently scheduled to coincide with other planned functions or by stand alone presentations.

These programs are designed to be interesting, informative and relevant to the problems of today. The information presented will emphasize the fact that all citizens are potential victims. By realizing this fact, a plan can be formulated to reduce your chances of being a victim as well as being able to effectively and efficiently report crime when it does happen.

The Sheriff's Office representative presenting these programs will be able to provide information regarding current trends and the best ways to avoid being a victim.

# Property Security Surveys

The second goal of Faith Watch is to provide the congregation with a secure place to meet and worship. Upon the request of a staff member, a representative of the Sheriff's Office will conduct a security survey of your buildings and grounds. During the process, the Santa Barbara County Sheriff's Office staff member will examine doors, windows, locks, lighting, alarm systems and environmental surroundings in order to give advise on various ways to make buildings more secure.

Information will be provided about the quality of security hardware, doors and windows. Other preventive measures will also be discussed that will assist to help detect the criminal element. In most instances, these measures can stop the amateur burglar and possibly slow down the experiences one, thus increasing the risk of being caught. Helpful hints will also be provided on how to avoid the common mistakes which makes the property and individuals vulnerable.



### Listing of Available Resources

The third goal of Faith Watch is to establish a complete listing of participating churches, synagogues and mosques in the County of Santa Barbara. The objective is to "network" these groups with a contact person listed for each congregation and to pool the potential resources, if necessary. The concept will be very beneficial to the individual organizations and congregations of Santa Barbara County should a situation arise that requires a large number of people to be mobilized quickly.

The Faith Watch program will reach thousands of citizens in faith based communities. This program will also foster a closer working relationship between the Santa Barbara County Sheriff's Office and the citizens that are served in the community. With the combined efforts of law enforcement and the citizens of the community, together a difference can be made.
