## **PURPOSE**

To understand the legal mandate for hospital notification to law enforcement when hospital personnel suspects a specific crime of violence as defined by 11160(b)(1) PC

## PROCEDURE

Hospital personnel are mandated to make immediate telephonic notification to law enforcement when it is suspected or it is brought to their attention that a patient is a victim of a violent crime as defined by 11160(b)(1) PC.

- 1. The hospital will telephonically contact the dispatch center to make notification.
  - a. Hospital staff is mandated by law to relay the following information telephonically to law enforcement:
    - i. The name of the injured person.
    - ii. The injured person's location.
    - iii. The character and extent of the person's injury.
    - iv. The identity of any person the injured person alleges inflicted the wound, other injury, or assaultive or abusive conduct upon the injured person.
- 2. The call taker shall enter a report call in CAD and shall ensure the information in section 1 above is obtained and relayed to the responding deputy.
  - a. In addition to the information above, the call taker shall attempt to obtain the location where the crime occurred so the appropriate substation can investigate the complaint.
  - b. Hospital personnel are required to obtain the name of the call taker they made the telephonic notification to.
- 3. Deputies who need to contact patients at either Santa Barbara Cottage Hospital or Goleta Valley Cottage Hospital may call Cottage Security at (805) 569-7319 to have Cottage personnel meet them for escort. Investigating deputies may also ask Dispatch to make this call.
