EVICTION INSTRUCTIONS TO THE SHERIFF OF SANTA BARBARA COUNTY

The Sheriff requires original instructions signed by the attorney of record or the plaintiff if they have no attorney. (CCP 262) You must submit the original writ, or an electronically filed writ with a writ declaration.

YOU MUST ALSO COMPLETE THE <u>SAFETY ASSESSMENT FORM</u> OR YOUR EVICTION MAY BE DELAYED. (FORM MUST BE SIGNED)

NOTEPer CCP 262, if you have been represented by an attorney during the eviction process, the attorney of record <u>must</u> sign the Sheriff's instructions. If you were not represented by an attorney, you as the plaintiff must sign the instructions. A plaintiff's agent or representative <u>may not</u> sign the Sheriff's instructions unless they are the attorney representing you as described above.

The Sheriff will not cancel any eviction without written and signed instructions from the plaintiff or their attorney. Faxed instructions from the plaintiff or attorney will be sufficient to cancel an eviction; however, we must receive the original letter of cancellation as soon as possible after the faxed letter of cancellation. WE DO NOT ACCEPT PHONE CANCELLATIONS. The Sheriff is entitled to his fee for service whether or not the service is successful (GC 26738).
