



## **Restorative Justice Class Information**

*The Santa Barbara Sheriff's Office reserves  
the right to refuse this program to violators.*

The restorative justice class is a voluntary program that requires participants to attend an up to two-hour presentation. The class focuses on safety in Isla Vista as well as improving community relations and partnerships. Participants will be assigned up to four hours of community service in Isla Vista. Upon completing the class and community service the participant's fine of up to \$300 will be waived and the citation will not go on their permanent record.

The participant must register for the class within 30 days of receiving the citation and must complete both the class AND community service hours within 60 days or the citation will be forwarded to the court.

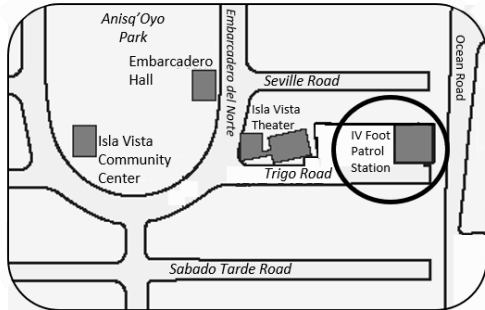
### **CLASS ELIGIBILITY**

To be eligible, the following criteria must be met:

- The following violation codes: 36-2 CO, 36-3 CO, 40-2 CO, 24-34 CO, 25662 BP, 25661 BP, 11362.3(a)(1) HS, 1993-2 IVPRD, and other victimless crimes on a case-by-case basis.
- Citation issued by the Sheriff's Office in Isla Vista.
- Participants may only attend the program once.
- Must register for the class within 30 days of receiving the citation.

## **How to register for the Restorative Justice Class**

- Register for the class by going to the Isla Vista Foot Patrol Station: 6504 Trigo Road



### **Hours of Operation M-F 8:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.**

- Bring your citation and personal identification.
- Classes are generally held on weekday nights.
- Exact dates and location TBD and will be announced via email after signing up.
- Community service will be coordinated around your school/work schedule.

If you fail to complete the entire class or the assigned community service, your citation will be forwarded to court.

After successfully completing the class and community service, your citation will be dismissed.
